Lunch: Free school packed lunch will be provided which includes a cheese sandwich and a sweet treat. Feel free to add snacks to top up the packed lunch. Pupils will take their class water bottle with them on the trip

Please make sure that the school is fully updated on any medical conditions your child has. Please note that if your child has a serious medical condition, a doctor's letter may be required. If this equipment is not in school, the pupil will be unable to go on this trip.
